The Lighting of the Candles (Four candles will be lit)

Minister: We light this candle for all mothers who have loved and laughed and laboured, as they cared for their children.

All: May God's love shine through them.

Minister: We light this candle for all mothers who have wept in sorrow over their children; for all those who have lost children or mothers; and for all for whom this is a day of sadness.

All: May God's peace be with them.

Minister: We light this candle for Jesus, born of a woman and nurtured in her love, and we praise you for Mary, a reminder of your patient, waiting love.

All: Blessed be God for ever. Amen.

Collect – Let us pray:

God of compassion,
whose Son Jesus Christ, the child of Mary,
shared the life of a home in Nazareth,
and on the cross drew the whole human family to himself:
strengthen us in our daily living
that in joy and in sorrow
we may know the power of your presence
to bind together and to heal;
through Jesus Christ your Son our Lord. **Amen.**
